

ST. JOHN'S ROD AND GUN CLUB
MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

NAME

1. The name of the Association shall be the St. John's Rod and Gun Club, hereinafter referred to as the Association.
2. The registered office of the Association will be located in the city of St. John's, in the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, Canada.

OBJECTS

3. The objects of the Association are:
 - (a) to encourage the protection and restoration of waters, wildlife, forest, and field;
 - (b) to educate the general public in recognizing resource conservation as vital to our way of life;
 - (c) to support legislation designed to curtail or eliminate activities destructive to natural resources;
 - (d) to support activities seeking to replenish or renew natural resources;
 - (e) to cooperate with provincial agencies involved in improving and strengthening resources through wise utilization;
 - (f) to promote the highest standards of sportsmanship and to foster farmer-sportsman cooperation;
 - (g) to stimulate and encourage public interest in natural resources and resource management;
 - (h) to promote organizations with similar objectives, giving them aid, counsel, and support in resolving problems of local, community or provincial scope;
 - (i) to purchase, lease, exchange, or otherwise acquire any lands, buildings, easements, right of common property real or personal, which may in the opinion of the Executive aid in the fulfillment of the objectives of the Association;

- (j) to promote and hold either alone or jointly with any other Association, club, or person, sporting competitions, and to offer, give, or otherwise contribute towards prizes, medals, and awards for said competitions;
 - (k) to raise money for, and/or make contributions to, any charitable or other worthy causes;
 - (l) to promote good sportsmanship, marksmanship and the safe handling of all types of firearms.
4. The income, profits and property of the Association howsoever derived, shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Association as set forth in this Memorandum of Association and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or other means, to any member of the Association. Provided that nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment in good faith to any member of the Association or any other person in return for any services actually rendered, or goods delivered to the Association.
5. The liability of the members is limited.
6. If any member of the Association receives any dividend, bonus or other profit in contravention of paragraph four of this Memorandum his liability shall be unlimited.
7. If on the winding up or dissolution of the Association there remains after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed amongst the members of the Association, but shall be given or transferred to some other Association having objects similar to the objects of this Association, and which shall prohibit the distribution of its income and property amongst its members.
